

The Bible

The books of the Old Bible were written from 1550 to 400 B.c. and those of the New between 44 and 100 A.D.

Mark 16:14,15 After Christ arose the disciples were told to preach the gospel in all the world.

Like 24:27,44-51 They were to preach from the Old Bible. The New Bible had not yet been written.

Acts 10:43 Peter said all the Old Testament prophets taught the gospel.

Acts 26:22,23 Paul preached nothing but the Old Bible, and said it was written for us,
Romans 15:4

ICor 10:11,4 2Tim 3:14-17 Paul told Timothy to continue in the Old Testament scriptures he had known as a child. They teach faith in Jesus and His doctrines.

2 Tim 4:1-4 A day would come when men would not endure Old Testament teachings.

John 1:45; 20:31 The gospels were written to prove the Old Bible is true, Jesus is the Son of God.

Ro 1:1,2,7,8 ICor 1:1,2 Rev 1:4 The Epistles and Revelation were written to churches established in the gospel by the Old Bible before the New was written.

2 Pe 3:2 Christians follow the Old and the New.

2 Tim 2:15 We must study to divide the Word properly.

Isa 28:9,10 To understand a subject, gather together the texts from here and there on the same subject.

Luke 24:27 Jesus traced His subject through the Bible.

2 Peter 1:20 We can have no private interpretation of Scripture.

John 7:17 If we are willing to do, we shall know the way.

John 16:12,13 We need the Holy Spirit to guide us.

Jer 29:13; 33:3 If we truly desire to know truth and ask God to help, He has promised to show us what we don't know.
