Ex 20:8-11 God says the seventh day is the Sabbath.

Convert's Catechism of Christian Doctrine, Rev. Peter Geiermann, C. SS. R., p. 50:

"Questions: Which is the Sabbath day? Answer: Saturday is the Sabbath day. Questions: Why do we observe Sunday instead of Saturday? Answer: We observe Sunday instead of Saturday because the Catholic church, in the council of Laodicea (AD. 336), transferred the solemnity from Saturday to Sunday."

Catholic World, (New York), March 1894, p. 809: "The church took the pagan Sunday and made it the Christian Sunday: .. And thus the pagan Sunday, dedicated to Balder, became the Christian Sunday, sacred to Jesus.

In 321 AD., the Roman Emperor, Constantine, made the first Sunday law as follows: "All judges and city people and the craftsmen shall rest upon the venerable Day of the Sun. Country people, however, may freely attend to the cultivation of the fields."

At the Council of Laodicea, 364 AD., the Catholic Bishops decreed that, "Christians shall not Judaize and be idle on Saturday, but shall work on that day. If they are found Judaizing, (that is, keeping the Sabbath) they shall be shut out from Christ."

Minutes of the Catholic Provincial of Bergen Norway, 1453: "Saturday keeping we forbid under penalty of severe church punishment."

DID JESUS CHANGE THE SABBATH?

Col 1:14-16 Jesus, the Creator, made the Sabbath.

Mark 2:27,28 Jesus is the Lord of the Sabbath.

Luke 4:16 Jesus customarily kept the Sabbath.

Matt 24:20 When Jerusalem was destroyed in AD. 70, the disciples had been praying for nearly 40 years that they would not have to flee on the Sabbath, as Jesus instructed them to do.

Luke 23:55,56 Jesus' closest friends had not been told of any change of the Sabbath.

Gal 3: 15 After one is dead his will cannot be changed. Jesus did everything the people before the cross and those after the cross were to do, as an example, but he never kept Sunday.

DID APOSTLES CHANGE THE SABBATH?

Acts 13:13, 14,42-44 Paul, apostle to the Gentiles, spoke two Sabbaths to Jews and Gentiles.

Acts 16:12, 13 In a Gentile city Paul kept Sabbath by the river.

Acts 17:1, 2 Paul teaches 3 Sabbaths. It is his custom.

Acts 18:1-4, 11 Paul worked during the week and taught Jews and Gentiles every Sabbath for 1 1/2 years. Altogether we have record of 84 specific Sabbaths.
