

How to Keep the Sabbath

Deut 5:12 How did God command?

Gen 2: 1-3 The Sabbath is a blessed, hallowed, sanctified rest day

Eze 46: 1 There are 6 working days and one Sabbath day.

Ex 20:8-11 We cannot do our own work or allow others to do it for us. The Sabbath is to be remembered.

Mark 15:42 It is kept in mind every day but the 6th day is special preparation day.

Ex 16:23 On Friday the baking, boiling, cleaning, etc., are done

Neh 13:15-19 No buying or selling is done on the Sabbath day.

Isa 58:13 No talking of business or worldly pleasure, or doing our own ways.

Ex 34:21 No financial or weather emergencies permit working on the Sabbath, for our own gain.

Amos 8:5 Guard the edges of the Sabbath. This is nicely done by family worship at sunset both days.

Lev 23:32; Dent 16:6 The Sabbath begins at sunset on Friday and ends at sunset on Sabbath.

Num 28:4, 9 Israel offered double offerings on Sabbath.

Lev 23:3 The Sabbath is therefore a day to convene for special worship and to receive special blessings.

Luke 4:6 Jesus worshiped at the synagogues on the Sabbath.

Matt 12:8-12 He said it was lawful to do well on the Sabbath day.

1 John 2:6 If we abide in Him, we shall follow His example.

Heb 10:25 We should not forsake assembling together.

Matt 11:28-30 We find spiritual rest from sin in Jesus, and come apart with Him on Sabbath days to fellowship and rest together.

Isa 66:22,23 We shall worship before Him every Sabbath in the new earth.
